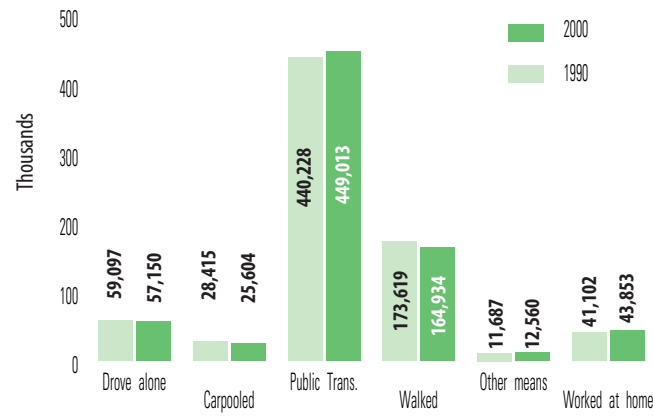

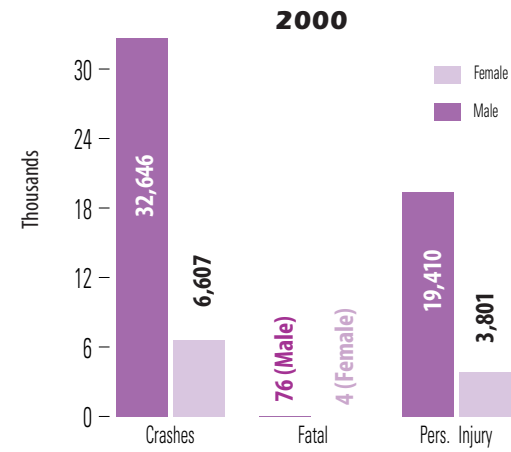

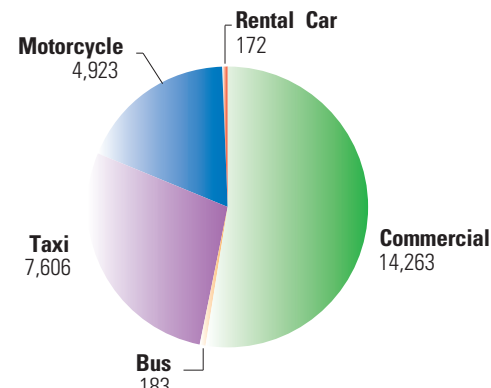
Male and Female Drivers in Vehicle Crashes

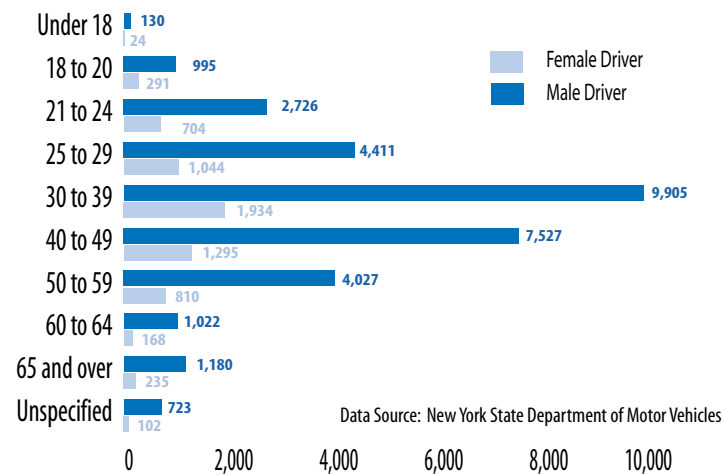
Motor Vehicle Registrations 2000

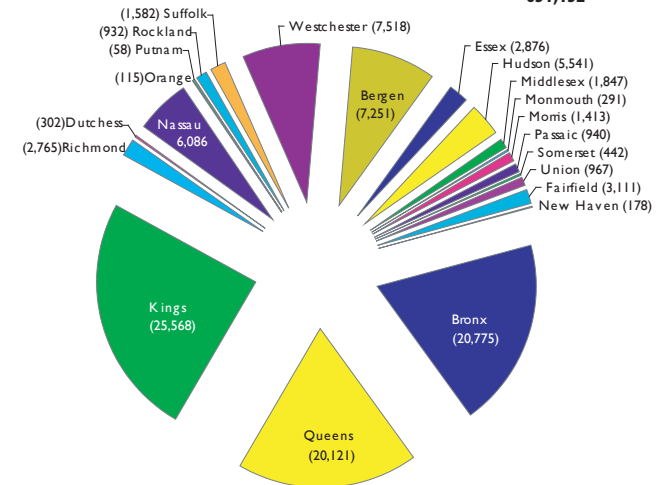
Crashes by Age for Male and Female Drivers 2000

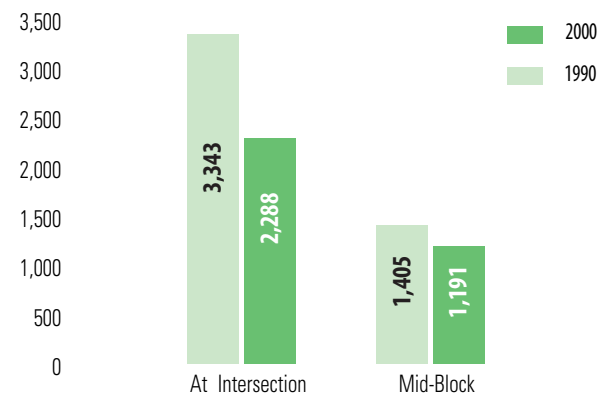
Journey to Work from New York County 2000

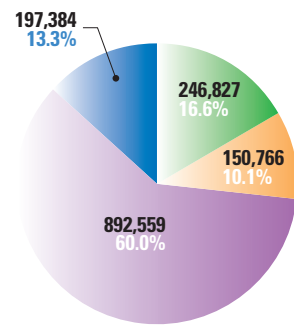

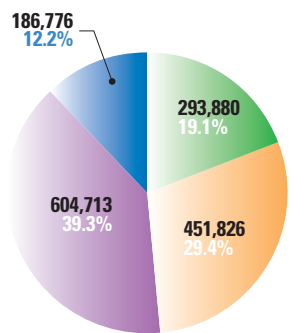

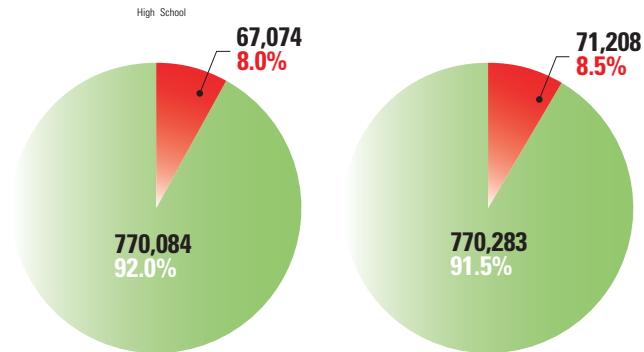

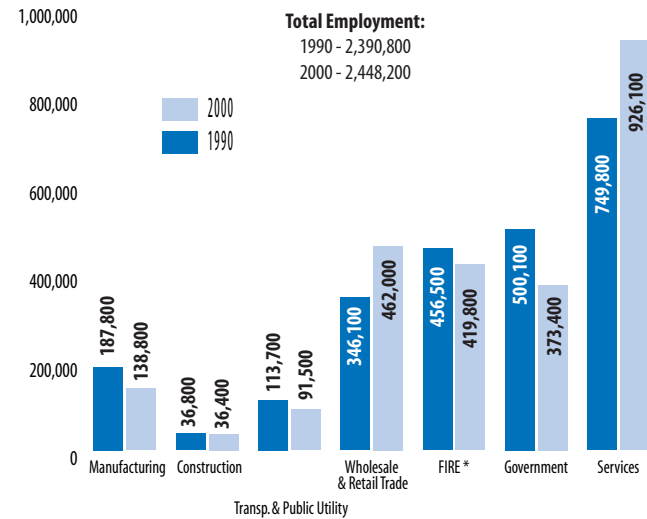

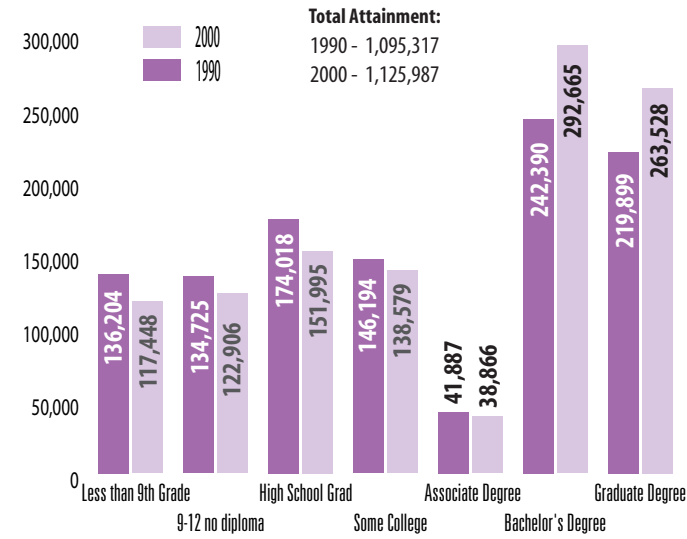
Non-Agricultural Employment by Industry Category 1990 and 2000



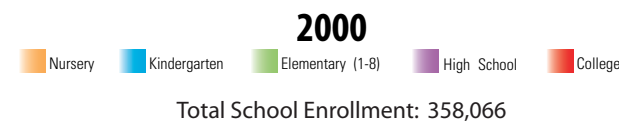

Educational Attainment 1990 and 2000

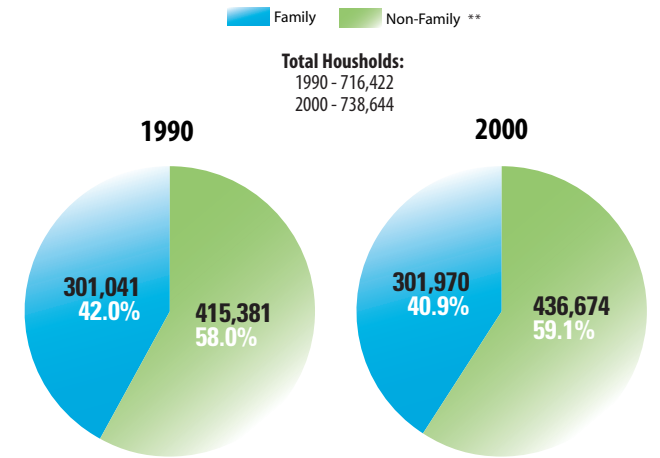


School Enrollment 2000



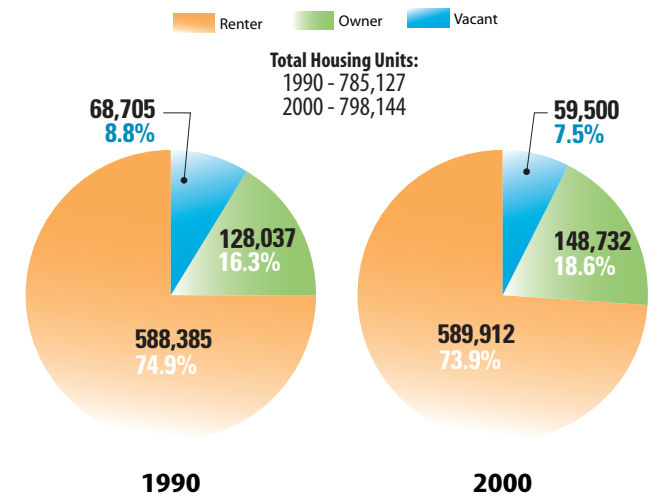
