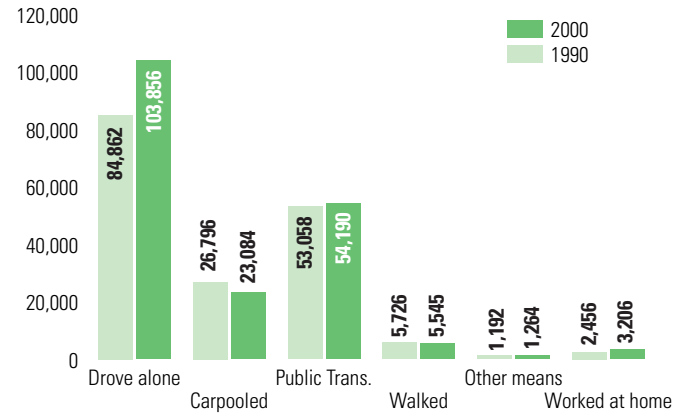

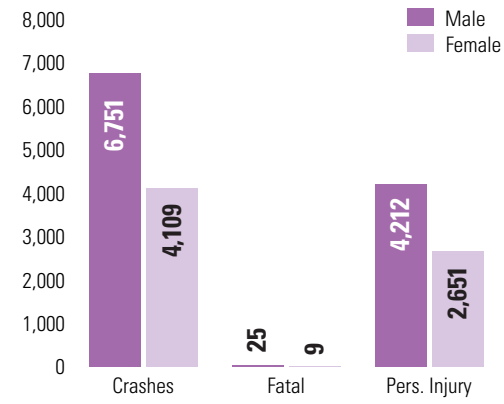

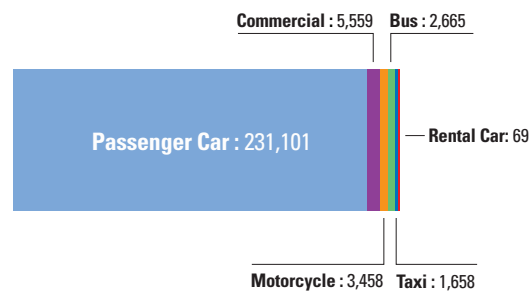

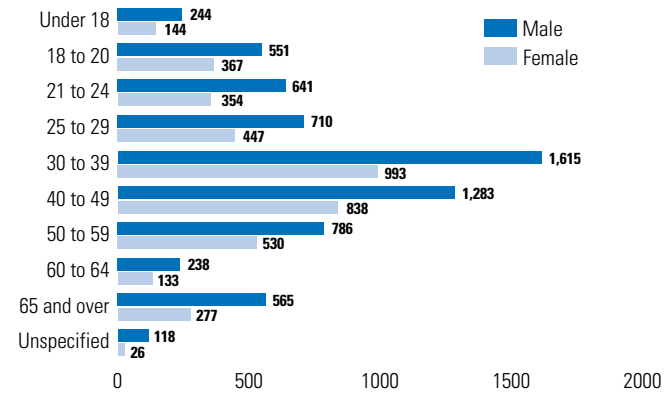
Male and Female Drivers in Vehicle



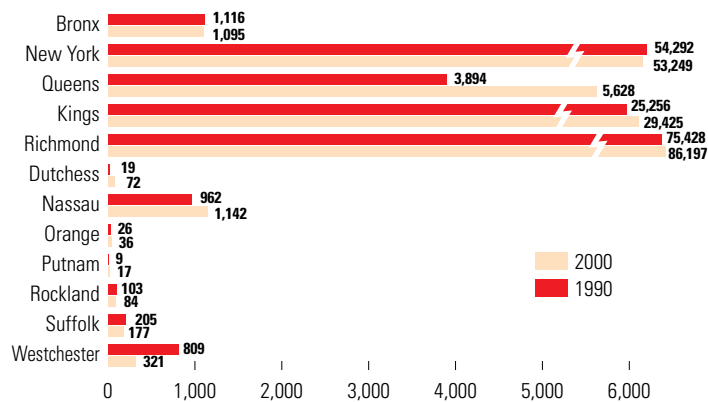
Motor Vehicle Registrations 2000



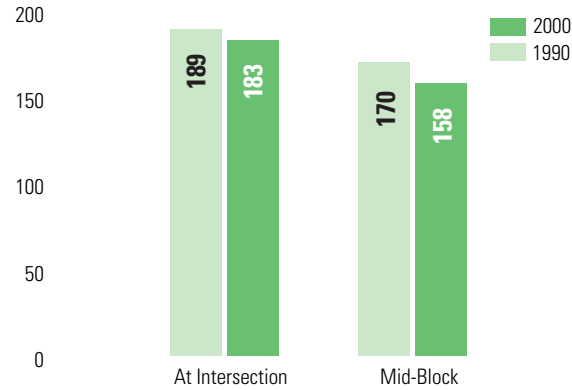
Crashes by Age for Male and Female Drivers 2000

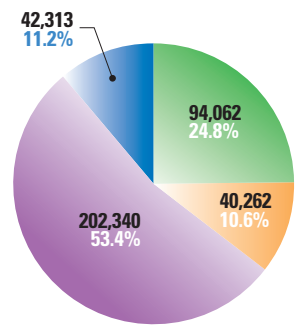

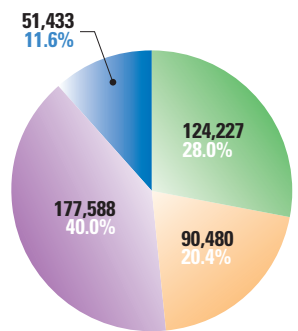
17 and Under 18 to 24 25 to 64 65 and Older

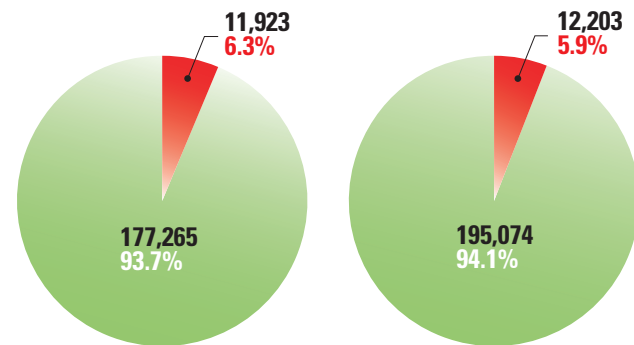

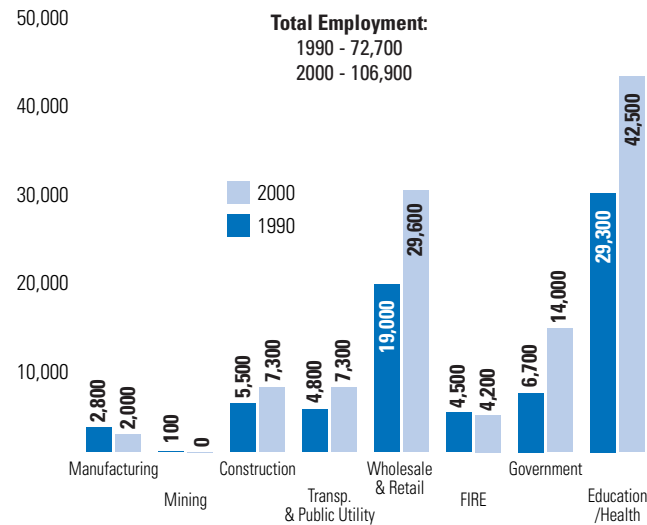

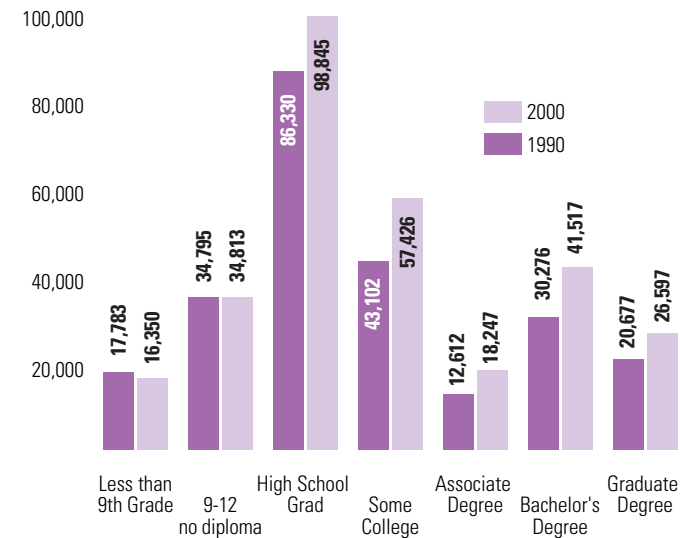
Non-Agricultural Employment by Industry Category 1990 and 2000

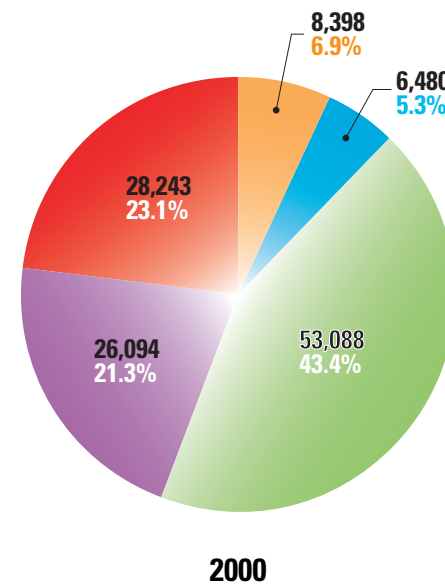

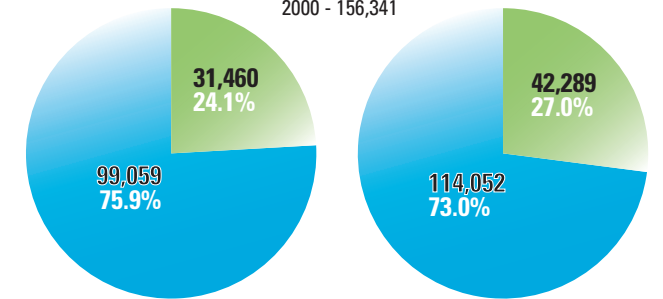

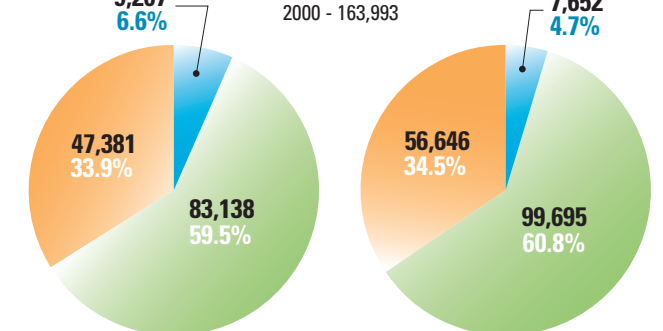
